- 6. Project Impact: Explain the lasting impact of the project and what a successful project outcome will look like. (No more than 200 words.)

Important Information

Reporting Requirements (recommended length one page):

- A concise impact report that describes the scope of the project. Please include at least one example of engagement with project participants
- A description of how the objectives of the grant were achieved can be bullet points
- A brief budget report detailing how the funds were used
- Mention how AEEA was recognized during the program or event
- At least one photograph of the project in action

Helpful Definitions:

- Formal education: education activities and projects conducted by a school, PreK-college level.
- Non-formal education: education activities and projects led by an organization other than a school, such as a nature center, government agency, non-profit organization, or community/civic organization.
- Goal: Overall aim the project will help achieve, which may be longer-term and extend beyond this grant.
- Objectives: Specific, measurable implementation steps within the grant period that will help realize the goal.
- Outcomes: The quantitative or qualitative change that you expect to happen as a result of the grant.
- Outputs: Direct and short-term results of activities which are necessary but not sufficient to produce the targeted outcomes.
